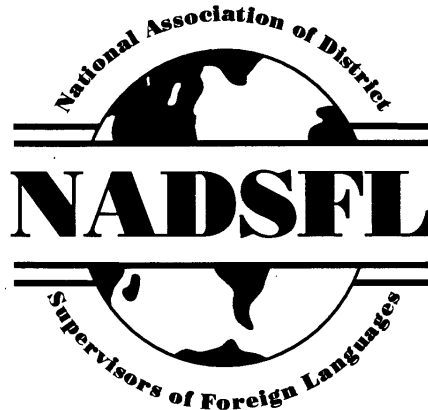

Fast Facts about History of NADSFL



Did you know that?

- NADSFL began in 1984 with one facilitator and six members
- At the second meeting in 1985 the group of nine met as part of the post-conference period.
- The original bylaws were originally taken from the National Science Supervisors document and changed to apply to Foreign Language Supervision.
- In 1987 this organization's name was NASFL, dues were \$10 a year, and the Regional Reps came on board.
- In 1988 NADSFL had its first president and not just a chairperson.
- In 1989 Erwin Petri and Paul Garcia were co-presidents.
- In 1993 membership rose to 135 members and dues were \$20.00 a year.
- In 1995 we began to be represented at JNCL by Pat Barr-Harrison who is still our representative.
- In 1996 NADSFL voted on acceptance of our logo.
- The largest NADSFL meeting ever held was in November 1999 in Dallas Texas when 142 participants joined us for this meeting.
- In 2002 the NADSFL website was ready for use by the membership to access the registration form, meeting reports and surveys.
