Best Practices for Foreign Language

Evidence of detailed planning and preparation
Classroom procedures/routines/management plan are established
Teacher uses target language as the normal and expected means of classroom communication and instruction
Teacher provides hands-on experiences for students, accompanied by oral and written language
Grammatical structures and vocabulary are introduced and used in meaningful contexts
Lesson links to the PISD LOTE curriculum
Teacher provides smooth and logical transitions from one activity to another
Teachers and students use visuals and realia effectively
Teacher gives clear directions and examples through modeling
Evidence of Learning Targets and National Standards in planning and instruction
Integration of target culture is evident and appropriate
Specific procedure/activity as students enter the room
Focus and/or goal of the lesson is in terms of what students can do with language
Use of manipulatives/graphic organizers/other nonlinguistic support
Integration of technological resources
Learning Targets posted for student use
Lesson leads to student centered activities
Evidence of effective formative assessment – teacher monitors student progress and adjusts as necessary
